

## 1906-1907 Batavia High School Boys Basketball

Batavia boys and girls were competing in high school basketball very early in the 1900s. It is believed that this team was a combined team from both East Batavia High School and West Batavia High School. The two separate high schools did not officially combine until 1911, although they did have some shared athletic programs prior to this date. Photographs were taken by Swan Studios in Batavia.



Guards are Atherton Hobler and Harold Bailey, the center is Jones, and the forwards are Walter Burke, Roy Carlisle, and Meredith Mallory (team captain). The coach was Clarence Jones.

- Atherton Hobler became an advertising executive in New York City.
- Harold Bailey remained in Batavia (profession unknown)
- Jones became an athletic instructor in Athens, Georgia.
- Walter Burke moved to Ohio (profession unknown)
- Roy Carlisle became a farmer in New York State.
- Meredith Mallory became a physician and surgeon in Orlando.
