- ❑ This program will be held at Sam Rotolo Middle School, 1501 S. Raddant Road in Batavia.
- ❑ Classes will meet Monday through Friday beginning June 21 to July 16, 2010. (no class on Wednesday, June 23).
- ❑ Class times are included in the course description below.
- ❑ The fee for each class is \$65.00.
- ❑ Transportation will not be provided.
- ❑ “Completed Grades K-5” in the Course and Description portion of this brochure refers to eligibility requirement for a particular class, i.e., “K-5” means that students who have completed grades K, 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5 are eligible to enroll in the class; “Grades 3-5” means only students who have completed grades, 3, 4, or 5 are eligible.
- ❑ **Payment and registration** are requested to be received by **June 4, 2010**.

Course Numbers and Descriptions

- #1 **Creative Arts** (Completed Grades K-5 - 10:00-10:45 a.m.) This class will make creative projects based on different themes. Students will create their own games as well as other 3 dimensional projects. If you enjoy being creative, this class is for you. **Please bring a paint shirt.**
- #2 **Summertime Art** (Completed Grades K-2 - 8:30-9:15 a.m.) Many different projects using a variety of mediums will be completed during the 4 weeks. Painting, printing, drawing, and three-dimensional activities are being planned for students. If you like working with your hands to create works of art, you will enjoy this class. **Please bring a paint shirt.**

- #3 **Art for Intermediates** (Completed Grades 3-8 – 9:15-10:00) Intermediate level students will enjoy drawing, painting, and working with many different mediums as they create their own pieces of art. **Please bring a paint shirt.**
- #4 **Baby-sitting** (10:00-10:45 a.m.) Responsibility and planning for a job as a baby-sitter will be stressed in this class. Safety, first aid, arts and crafts, games, songs, and activities will be discussed and tried.
- #5 **Simple Machine Project** (Completed Grades 3-6, 8:30-9:15 a.m.) This class will study the six simple machines. They will learn how simple machines work and construct a project to accomplish a simple task. Students will need to supply their own materials for projects.
- #6 **Computer** (Completed Grades 1 – 3, 10:45 a.m. – 11:30 a.m.) During the computer course students will learn about computing basics and how to effectively use computers at school and at home. Students will also learn keyboarding basics which allows the students to be more effective in the electronic world. They will also use Microsoft Word to learn basic word processing skills. Wrapping up the course, students will learn how to do basic Internet searches and stay safe on the Internet.
- #7 **Digital Movies** (Completed Grades 4-8, 9:15 a.m.- 10:00 a.m.) Using Microsoft Movie Maker students will learn how to take their own photographs and music to create digital movies. Students will learn how to scan paper photographs into a computer and how to download images from digital cameras onto their computers to use in their movies. Students will need blank CDs for their projects.
- #8 **Fun with Foods** (Completed Grades K-2 - 9:15-10:00 a.m.) (Completed Grades 3-5, 8:30-9:15) Learn about healthy eating while preparing and sampling a variety of fun foods. A \$5.00 fee will be charged for supplies.
- #9 **French** (Completed Grades 1-6 – 10:45-11:30 a.m.) This class is an introduction to the French language and French culture.
- #10 **A Taste of Kindergarten** (10:00-10:45 a.m.) This program is for your child who is about to enter kindergarten. The children will be given an introduction to the kindergarten curriculum through developmentally appropriate activities such as music, story time, and creative arts. This will also be a great way to meet friends who may be future classmates!
- #11 **Beyond Kindergarten** (Completed Kindergarten - 10:45-11:30 a.m.) This program will continue skills presented in kindergarten in math, reading readiness, writing, and science.
- #12 **Magic** (Completed Grades K-5, 9:15-10:00 a.m.) This class will focus on learning magic tricks. Show yourself and your family how dramatic, magical, and creative you really are!
- #13 **Math** (Completed Grades 1-3, 10:00-10:45 a.m.) This class is for students who enjoy Math. Math games, cooperative learning and hands-on activities are used to facilitate the learning process in this class.
- #14 **Math** (Completed Grades 4-7, 9:15-10:00 a.m.) This class offers a challenging environment for the student. It further develops concepts learned during the year by adding twists and turns to basic math. It is a fun adventure but not meant for students who have difficulties in math.

- #15 **Instrumental Music** - Beginning instrumental lessons are open to students who will be entering 5th or 6th grade in the fall. The music directors at the elementary schools will arrange Summer Music Registration Forms and class meeting times. The music directors will also collect tuition. **Please do not send with Enrichment Summer School information.**
- #16 **Science** (Completed Grades K-2 and 3-8 - 10:45-11:30 a.m.) Students will be participating in experiments dealing with scientific topics.
- #17 **Study Skills** (Completed Grade 3 or higher - 8:30-9:15 a.m.) This class will help develop independent learning skills including listening, organization, keeping a homework log, taking notes, taking tests, and reading a textbook. This class will be split into two classes if there are enough enrollments. **Please bring pencil, pen, paper and a folder.**
- #18 **That's Entertainment** (Completed Grades K-5 - 10:45-11:30 a.m.) During this session, your child will join in the fun of putting on a performance. This class may work with set design. **Please bring a paint shirt.**
- #19 **Where in the World...???** (Completed Grades 2 – 6, 10:45-11:30 a.m.) This class will look for answers to geography and the world around us through puzzles, games, exploration and practice. Have fun learning about the United States and the rest of the world this summer.
- #20 **Sew-Fun** (Completed Grades 1-6 - 10:00-10:45 a.m.) This class will make a project using a simple pattern you choose. We will begin by making a bag for supplies. Students will be responsible for purchasing a pattern and fabric after the first week of class. No sewing experience is necessary. Sewing machines will be used.
- #21 **Sign Language** (Completed Grades 1-8 - 10:45-11:30 a.m.) This is an introduction to sign language. Students will learn basic communication as well as an introduction to deaf culture.
- #22 **Woodworking** (Completed Grades 5 - 8 - 10:00-10:45 a.m.) This is a beginning class where students will need to bring a hammer, wood nails, sandpaper, etc. to work on simple activities. A list of wood pieces (sizes) will be given to students to bring for each project. (Limited to 12 students)
- #23 **Write It, They Will Read It** (Completed Grades 4 – 8 – 8:30-9:15 a.m.) Do you like to write and need a writing coach? Learn writing techniques that will astound and amaze your family and friends.
- #24 **Knitting** (Completed Grades 2-8, 10:45 – 11:30 a.m.) This class may make scarves, blankets, etc. Students will need to bring their own materials since projects may vary.
- #25 **Board Games/Chess** (Completed Grades K-5, 10:00-10:45 a.m.) This class will develop thinking skills through board games such as Chess and others. Games will depend on the age of students enrolled.
- #26 **Writer's Workshop** (Completed Grades 1-3, 8:30-9:15 a.m.) This is a chance to do mini-lessons along with creating stories of different genres.
- #27 **Music Class** (Completed Grades K-3, 8:30-9:15) This class is meant to learn about music, singing, and just having fun with music. They might even learn the 'chicken dance'!

GRASP SUMMER SCHOOL 2010

Students completing grades kindergarten through eight can participate in a supplemental summer program, Grand Rapids Academic Summer Program (GRASP). The purpose of this summer program is to work on critical reading and mathematics skills, which may need review during the summer. The program serves the needs of students who are average or just slightly below average in achievement in these two areas. The GRASP curriculum is aligned to the current state and national standards. The cost of the program is \$35.00 per single module or \$55.00 for two modules for each child served.

If you elect to participate in this program, your child will receive a packet of 10 lessons, computer scorable sheets, and a number two pencil for each academic area. You and your child must then complete each lesson and mail to GRASP (envelopes provided). You will receive an evaluation of each lesson's achievement by return mail. If your child completes all ten lessons, a certificate and reward will be received from GRASP.

If your child wishes to participate in this summer school program, fill out the registration form and attach a check made payable to the Batavia Public Schools in the amount of \$35.00 or \$55.00 and return the registration to your school office by **May 7, 2010**.
