You will play against other local "in-house teams". Each team will play 12-14 games starting late April and finish with a tournament at the end of June.

Please provide a jersey and pant size at registration. The Batavia Park District will conduct an evaluation at the Batavia High School Field House on Saturday, February 18. 10U will attend from 2:30-3:45 pm, 12U will attend from 4-5:15 pm and 14U will attend from 5:15-6:30pm. All volunteer coaches will need to help at the evaluation process if possible. The evaluation will be held to test the skill level of each player through a variety of drills. A draft will then be held by the park district and volunteer coaches to choose teams for the upcoming season. The age cutoff for each level is determined on where the participant's birth date falls as of December 31, 2011.
