- **Memorandum of Understanding with the BEA**

The Board of Education announced their acceptance of a Memorandum of Understanding with the Batavia Education Association (BEA). The BEA and Board of Education reached an agreement that will save the school district \$2.3 million in the 2010-11 school year. The agreement contains salary and benefit reductions for Batavia teachers that will help the district avoid teacher reductions.

- **Student Participation Fees**

The Board of Education reviewed administrative recommendation for increases in Student Participation fees effective beginning in the 2010-11 school year. The Board reviewed the recommendation, discussed fee implementation and philosophy behind participation fees. The Board will review the proposal again on March 23rd.

In the Consent Agenda the Board approved:

- An administrative request to dispose of surplus district property;
- An overnight field trip for the BHS Key Club;
- The voluntary offer of Tony Inglese, District Treasurer to forgo compensation for services as Treasurer effective April 1, 2010 and the Board of Education conduct a salary review of the Chief Information officers salary.
- A recommendation that the Board of Education offer only a half day kindergarten program beginning with the 2010-11 school year.

Board Members entered Closed Session to hear information on Personnel at 8:26 p.m.

Board Members returned to Open Session at 9:01 p.m. and adjourned.
