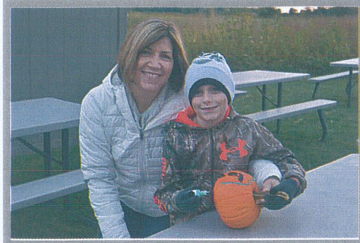

RECIPE

Breakfast Banana Pops



INGREDIENTS

-bananas	-mini chocolate chips
-yogurt of choice	-popsicle sticks
-granola of choice	

DIRECTIONS

Pour granola into a very shallow dish or plate. Peel bananas, cut in half, and insert popsicle sticks. Dip into yogurt (or coat with a knife), then roll into granola and add-ons. (try sticking the chips on by hand, after rolling in the granola.) Place on a parchment or wax-lined tray and freeze. Keep uneaten pops in the freezer.
