During the preschool years...

Parents often wonder if their child's development is typical of that seen in same age peers. Developmental screenings are designed to address these concerns and help parents learn more about their child's skills.

Batavia District 101 offers free developmental screenings throughout the school year to assess young children's skills. These screenings are conducted by a team of District Educators and Specialists and are available to families living within the Batavia School District whose children are 33 months to 5 years of age.

assesses your child's development in the areas of:

- Communication
- Gross Motor
- Fine Motor
- Problem-Solving
- Personal-Social



Proof of residency is required prior to scheduling an appointment.
