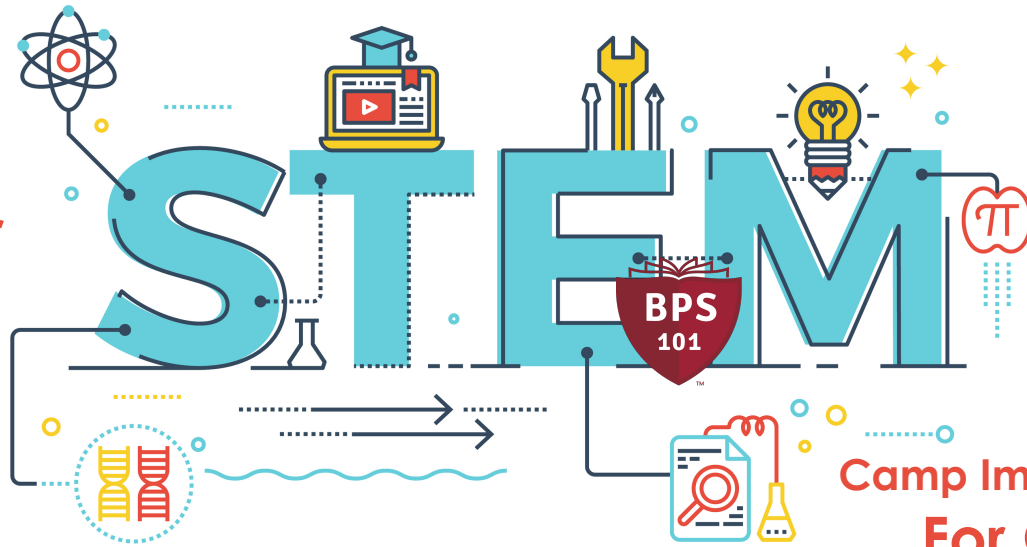


# Summer
