School Summary

Batavia High School was created by the merger of West Batavia High School and East Batavia High School (and their separate school districts) in 1911 and became part of Batavia Public School District 101. Enhanced by 1:1 technology, BHS is a comprehensive high school with rigorous academics in addition to excellent opportunities in athletics and fine arts. BHS remains the only public high school in Batavia and is on a collegiate-style block schedule.

Academics and Student Support

Core Content Areas: English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Physical Education, and Health.

Innovative & Enrichment Programs: Art, Music, Theater, Spanish, French, Latin, STEM, Project Lead the Way, Building Trades, INCubator Entrepreneurship, L.I.N.K. Internship Program, Batavia Fine Arts Centre Internship Program, Fox Valley Career Center, Child Care Education and Lab, Culinary Arts, Hospitality and Catering, PE Leadership Program, BATV, and college credit options.

Student Support: Offer multiple programs to support English learners, students with disabilities, and gifted and at-risk learners. Student services staff includes 5 counselors, 3 social workers, 3 psychologists, 1 career counselor, and 1 transition coordinator.

Dual Credit

At Batavia High School, students have the opportunity to graduate with up to 32 transferable college credits before starting their freshman year of college. Batavia High School currently offers 10 dual-credit courses.

The Class of 2019 had 569 dual-credit course enrollments, which is an increase of 29% from the Class of 2017.

AP/Honors

There are 16 Advanced Placement (AP) courses and 14 Honors courses offered at BHS. All Honors and AP courses taken at BHS earn an additional GPA point. The GPA highest honors benchmark is 4.38.
