School History

Grace McWayne Elementary School opened in 2001 and was named after Grace McWayne who taught in Batavia schools for 59 years. She is, and probably will always be, the educator with the longest tenure of service to the children of Batavia. GMS is one of six public elementary schools in Batavia and home to the District's K-5 Instructional Learning Program.

Academics and Student Support

Core Content Areas: Reading, Writing, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies

Innovative & Enrichment Programs: Art, Music, Physical Education, STEM, Health

Student Support: Offer programs to support English learners, students with disabilities (K-5 Instructional Learning Program), and gifted and at-risk learners. Student services staff includes 6 special education teachers, 2 social workers, 1 psychologist, an EL teacher and enrichment coach.

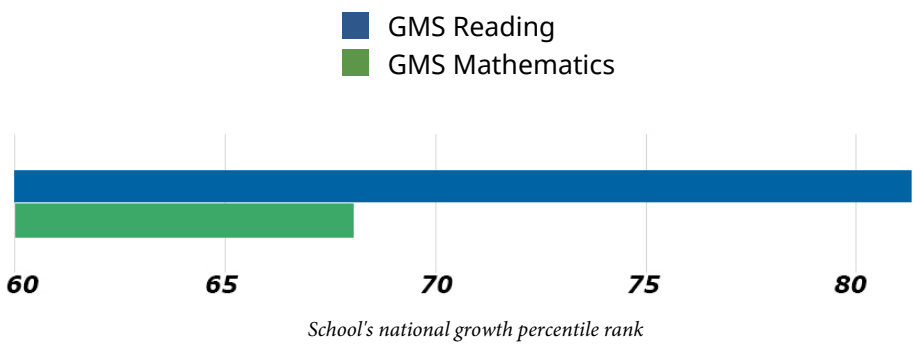

NWEA MAP Test Results

Grace McWayne School assesses all students in fall, winter, and spring with the NWEA MAP test in the areas of reading and mathematics. Based on 2018-19 national data, GMS students outgrew students nationwide by 82% in reading and 68% in math.

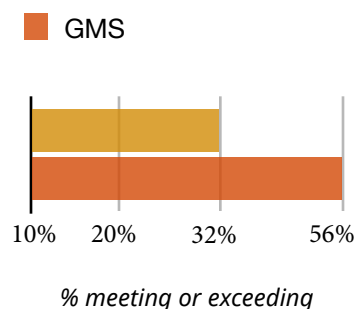
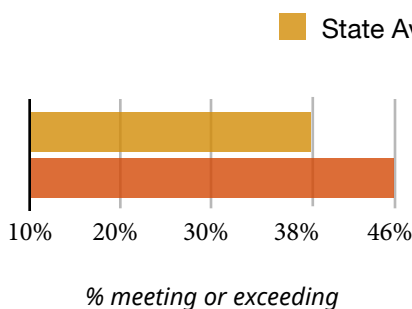


IAR Results Meeting and Exceeding
