## **School Summary**

The current Rotolo Middle School opened in 1993. This facility was originally named Batavia Middle School. Several years after its opening, the name was changed to Rotolo Middle School in honor of Sam Rotolo, who served as principal of Batavia's only middle school for 23 years. RMS is dedicated to leading all students to their maximum potential: academically, socially, emotionally, and physically. The middle school has been named a School to Watch<sup>®</sup> five times by the National Forum to Accelerate Middle-Grades Reform for its academic excellence, responsiveness to the unique challenges of early adolescence, and equity in providing every student with high-quality teachers, resources, and supports. RMS serves students in grades six through eight and is the only middle school in the District.



#### **NWEA MAP Test Scores**


Rotolo Middle School assesses all students in fall, winter, and spring with the NWEA MAP test in the areas of reading and mathematics. Based on 2018-19 national data, RMS students outgrew students nationwide by 79 percent in reading and 76 percent in math.



### **IAR Results Meeting and Exceeding**

BPS101 students also take the Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) assessment. In 2018-19, RMS students performed 15% better than the state average in Math and 6% better than the state average in English Language Arts.

#### IAR English Language Arts


