School Summary

J.B. Nelson Elementary School opened in 1955 and was named in honor of John B. Nelson, a math teacher at Batavia High School who went on to become the school's principal in 1921 and then District superintendent from 1938 to 1962. After retiring, he continued to serve BPS101 by substitute teaching at Batavia High School. JBN is one of six public elementary schools in Batavia.



NWEA MAP Test Results


J.B. Nelson School assesses all students in fall, winter, and spring with the NWEA MAP test in the areas of reading and mathematics. Based on 2018-19 national data, JBN students outgrew students nationwide by 79%* in reading and 86%* in math.

BPS101 students also take the Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) assessment. In 2018-19, JBN students performed 10%* better than the state average in Math and on par with the state average in English Language Arts.
