- Renovation and additional science labs
- Modernized library to better accommodate new technologies and resources
- Expanded and modernized elective classrooms (particularly foods and vocational)
- Locker room and restroom improvements to improve cleanliness and privacy
- Flexible and adaptable collaboration spaces that accommodate a variety of seating arrangements, technology, and resources to allow students to work in small groups on projects, conduct research, and share ideas
