Unless otherwise noted, register for programs on our online calendar beginning May 1.

**Baby Play & Learn** - Babies through 23 months of age and their caregivers are invited to play and learn on Friday, May 19 at 10:00 a.m. Meet other caregivers, enjoy playtime with your baby and see examples of early literacy activities. We ask that alternate care arrangements be made for older siblings.



<u>Chess Night</u> - Children ages 6 - 14 can play chess at the Library on Tuesday, May 9 at 7:00 p.m. Participants should have a basic knowledge of the game.

**Drop-In Craft -** Drop in on Thursday, May 11 and Wednesday, May 31 beginning at 10:00 a.m. to make a Mother's Day card. Materials are available while supplies last.

**Free Comic Book Day -** Children may stop by the Youth Services Desk for a free comic book on Saturday, May 6. Comic books available while supplies last.

**Playground Passport -** Pick up a Playground Passport from the Youth Services Desk, then spend the rest of your summer visiting playgrounds in Batavia.
