Attention Parents of Students Entering 12th Grade MENINGOCOCCAL IMMUNIZATION (MCV4) REQUIREMENT

Students entering grade 12 in the State of Illinois must be immunized for Meningitis. The immunization requirement consists of one dose of the Meningococcal Immunization after the age of 16 years before entry into 12th grade.

Proof of receiving the MCV4 vaccination(s) is required before the first day of school. According to BPS101 policy, students without proof of receiving the MCV4 vaccination will be excluded from school. The only exceptions are students with an approved medical or religious exemption on file with the school nurse.

Immunization verification must be submitted to the school nurse <u>before</u> the first day of school.
