## School Summary

H.C. Storm Elementary School opened in 1978 and was named after Howard Charles Storm (1881-1956) who was Batavia's superintendent of schools from 1916 to 1938. HCS is one of six public elementary schools in Batavia and is the center for the District's bilingual education program with the goal of building on our students' native language and becoming biliterate. The building underwent construction over the summer of 2025 adding a secure entry vestibule, along with a new front office and conference room.

**Innovative & Enrichment Programs:** Art, Music, STEM, Health, Physical Education

**Student Support:** Offer programs to support English learners, students with disabilities, and gifted and at-risk learners. Student services staff includes 3 special education teachers, 1 social worker, 1 psychologist, 1 ELL teacher, 2 speech pathologists, 2 interventionists, and 1 enrichment coach.
