Louise White Elementary School opened in 1978 and was named after Louise Conde White who was born in 1875, went to Batavia schools, taught in Batavia schools, and was a principal of Batavia’s East Side School from 1922-1934. LWS has 27.2 full-time equivalent teachers, with 65.4% of them holding a Master’s Degree or Higher.
